











Enrolment

Kerang Christian College welcomes all enrolment enquiries. The College is a co-educational, non-denominational, independent Christian school offering classes from Prep through Year 12.

Step 1 - Enquire

We welcome and consider all enrolment applications. If you would like to receive an Enrolment Information Pack or to make an appointment for a tour of the College, please telephone the Office on 5450 3894.

Step 2 - Apply

Submit the enrolment form, which must be signed by the parent(s)/ guardian(s). An enrolment application is a prerequisite to admission but not a guarantee of admission. An enrolment form can also be downloaded from the College website.

Kerang Christian College accepts transfer students on a case-by-case basis. enrolment are accepted throughout the year, subject to availability.

Step 3 - Offer an Interview

If the College is likely to be able to offer the required place, the PA to the Principal will telephone to arrange an interview with the Principal, parent(s)/guardian(s) and the student(s).

Step 4 - Offer of a Place

Following the interview, the College will notify the parent(s)/guardian(s) by a Letter of Offer, or otherwise, of the student's admission into the College. The College does not have an Application Fee for Primary or Secondary places; however, an Enrolment Fee of \$50 is charged per family in order to secure the first Enrolment offer.

About Us

Kerang Christian College is a non-denominational, coeducational, Christian College that commenced in 1983.

The College offers Primary and Secondary education from Prep to Year 12. Kerang Christian College aims to provide excellence in Christian education with a focus on the core subject areas of Maths, English, Geography, History, Science and Christian Living. Students also study Music, Art, Physical Education, ICT, LOTE (Auslan), Health, Woodwork, Food Technology, Textiles and Drama, enriching their learning experience.

Each classroom is fully-carpeted, individually climate controlled, has large windows for natural light, direct access to the verandah, covered walkways to the library, art room and other classes. Through well-kept and equipped facilities, the College seeks to make learning comfortable and effective.

The Australian Curriculum guides the instruction and assessments developed at Kerang Christian College.

Teachers at the College are Christians and are dedicated to challenging our students to achieve their best in a safe and supportive setting.

Students are encouraged to participate in a wide variety of extra-curricular activities. Many of these activities have a community focus but are also in place to make learning authentic. Students have an opportunity to participate in camps, excursions, sporting events, competitions, incursions, chapels, assemblies and much more

The motto at Kerang Christian College is Integrity, Faith, Family. The College believes it is important for students to develop sound values and aims to develop Christian faith and character in students. Furthermore, the College aims to equip students for service and citizenship as an expression of their Christian faith.

It is our prayer and desire that every student will have a positive experience at school, developing healthy relationships, achieving their personal best, maintaining physical and emotional well-being and developing a greater understanding of Christian faith and character.

Primary School (Prep - Year 6)

The Primary School at Kerang Christian College has a focus on meeting the needs of each individual student through developing an excellent working relationship with each student.

Each primary staff member must have an active Christian background, enabling staff to teach effectively from a Christian perspective and to commence each day with Bible reading and prayer.

The Prep-Year 6 curriculum has a strong focus on literacy and numeracy skills. Each day there is dedicated literacy time where students are focused on their reading, writing and spelling skills. Similarly, there is a numeracy time where students focus on their mathematical skills, processes, and thinking.

Classrooms are designed to facilitate learning through working individually, in small groups, in class groups, and in whole-school groups. The learning areas can be self-contained or can allow for flexible groups where peer tutoring and shared activities between classes can take place.

There is a Primary School assembly area and the library is close-by, giving easy access to resources and space for individual or small group work.

Specialist programs in the Primary School include Physical Education and LOTE, along with Performing and Visual Arts.

The Visual Arts wing includes a computer lab, sewing machines and work stations with varied heights and flexibility. The spacious art room provides Primary School students with a modern learning environment to participate in the art curriculum.

Kerang Christian College has a commitment to learning infused with technology, so every Primary classroom has access to laptop computers and each student has network access. With the use of laptops, touchscreen devices and classroom televisions, teachers can also provide students with interactive and online experiences.

Middle School (Years 7 - 9)

The Secondary School curriculum ensures students have a broad base when they make the transition to tertiary studies. Each student is encouraged to develop a deep understanding of his or her own thinking and learning. We believe that excellence in teaching, combined with a commitment to building positive relationships with students, leads to constructive learning environments, student engagement, and greater academic achievement.

In Years 7-10, a curriculum base of varied academic disciplines is designed to build deep knowledge and delay narrowing of options for as long as possible. A rich variety of core subjects caters for a range of student needs and talents.

The curriculum in Years 7-10 contains foundational subjects that all students undertake as they prepare for success in education, work, and living a Christian life. Creativity is encouraged through specialist subjects such as Performing Arts, Visual Arts, Food and Technology, LOTE, and Wood and Technology.

Students in Years 9 and 10 have an opportunity to participate in an elective program. The elective program allows students to have a greater choice and variety in subject selection. Electives also provide a chance for students to develop their passions and expertise in particular subjects while at the same time allowing them to take calculated risks, and to explore and try subjects they may not have tried before.

With a dedicated Christian staff, well-equipped modern facilities, and a vision for growth into the future, Kerang Christian College is well-placed to achieve its goal of creating a school community where every person is valued and nurtured, and is equipped for service and citizenship as an expression of their Christian faith.

As part of the transition from Primary to Secondary schooling, students are encouraged to engage with all aspects of school life. They attend Year 7 camp in Term 1, participate in a range of sporting and cultural activities offered throughout the year, develop friendships, and explore the environment outside of the school setting as they seek to advance their educational journey.

Senior School (Years 10 – 12)

The Senior School experience at Kerang Christian College is challenging, varied, and exciting, providing a variety of new possibilities for our students. Our Senior School program is designed to promote a more mature learning environment that is appropriate for 15 to 18 year olds. Students in Senior School will experience a diverse range of teaching styles. They will also be expected to participate in a wide variety of learning

Our Senior School program is focused on building academically-proficient students that demonstrate purpose and Christian character. Our desire is that over their years of Senior School, our students will strive to achieve and be inspired to take their learning into a career path that will enable them to use their God-given potential to make valuable contributions to our nation.

Kerang Christian College offers a wide variety of VCE subjects with the goal of catering to the life and career goals of each student. We provide opportunities and varied pathways that allow student choice in taking ownership of their education as they complete their educational journey with us and move into a path of further education or starting a career. Our offerings are enhanced through partnerships with other Christian schools, allowing the opportunity for Video Conference classes as needed. We also have the option to accelerate VCE in Year 10 as well as flexibility to arrange school-based apprenticeships or traineeships in conjunction with VCE where they fit with a student's career path. Not only do we provide opportunities in the classroom, but we also arrange trips to career expos, university visits, and learning experiences outside the classroom.

Our students are encouraged to strive for educational excellence, endeavouring to achieve to the best of their ability. We aim to best prepare our students for Secondary graduation and a pathway to University, TAFE or the workforce. Senior School students have the full support of a close-knit, caring team of staff who are committed to helping students set and achieve their goals and to establish strong habits of learning that will continue to grow our students beyond their time at Kerang Christian College.
